

## Describe why you chose this tier!

We chose to revisit Tier 2, decision making as a collective, because our dynamic had shifted. Having spent more time together, we now understand each other better, allowing us to ask more precise questions and move beyond the earlier stages of open ended curiosity.



At the same time, we were aware that we would be working with horses, introducing a new relationship between “us” as a collective and “the other.” This created a different set of conditions compared to previous residencies, where coexistence and responsiveness became central.

Returning to Tier 2 allowed us to re-engage with our decision making process under these new circumstances. During this phase, we developed a pendulum structure using a rope suspended from the ceiling and a bottle of lilac paint, with the floor covered in paper. This led to a process of mapping words and reorganising them, creating a dialogue between movement, material, and collective thought.

## Why?

The decision making task as it had strongly resonated with the group. It created a clear focus within the process, and we became curious about why we had been so productive during the initial phase.

Through this, we recognised that our group dynamic allowed space for collective creativity to emerge through shared decision making. The works we produced during that time had a lasting impact on the group, prompting us to return to the task in order to better understand and build on those conditions.

**How?** We tried different versions of “deciding on an outcome” together. We again used the material color and paper. Now in a smaller scale pen and an A3 paper. We all had one or two fingers on the pen so it was kind of stable and had room for movement. We committed to the process and giggled. We tried letting the pen lead us to a conclusion naturally, and another approach where we all prematurely decided on *what* we were drawing but not *how*. Later we moved on to creating exquisite corpses - by drawing and writing. And interpreting them together in space, as scores.



**What came out?** It's an ongoing discussion. It will reveal itself in the future. Time for once is on our side. Knowing when to lead, follow, ask for help or clarification.

Power to the process, yiha!
