

## Collective Contribution - Forgó kollektíva, Hungary

**F** = Format/context

**M** = Movement/physicality/practice

**T** = Theme/topic

- Our 5 *TOPICS* and their *ROLES* indicated by the capital letters - no specific order -

Audience role - **F**

Gentle dance - **M**

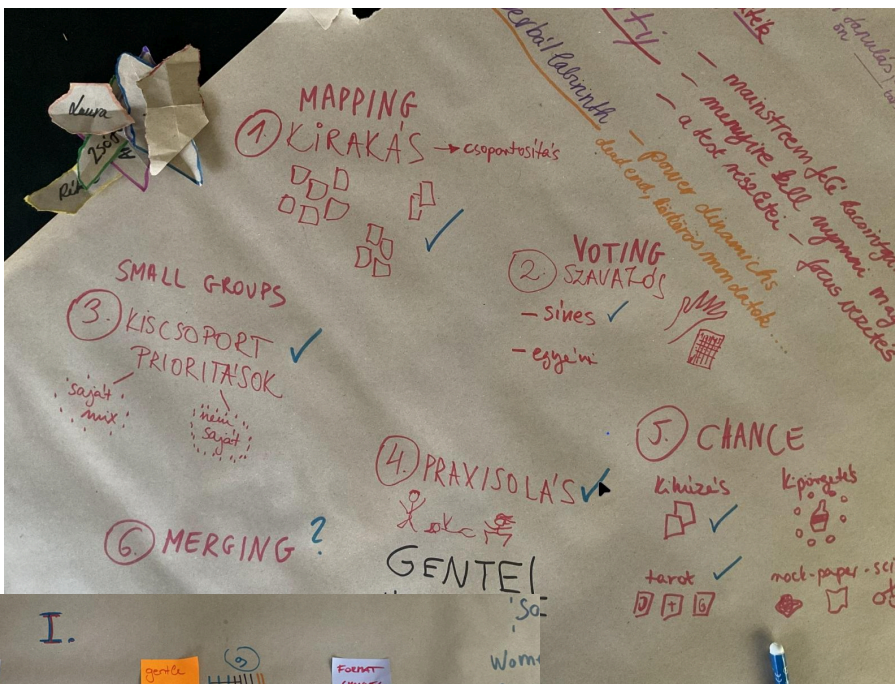
Verbal labyrinth - **F, M**

The destructive woman - **T, M**

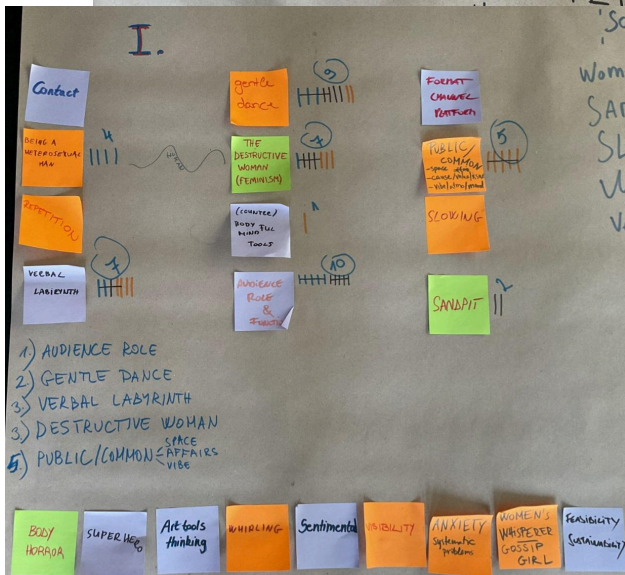
Public space - **F, T**

- The decision making process that was used for the final list: democratic decision by *VOTING*
  - List of 21 topics altogether (3 topics per person and we are 7 people)
  - Everyone makes individually a list of 7 topics (no order, can include their own topics)
  - Separating into 2 groups (groups of 3 and 4 people) by voting
  - Each group makes a list of 7 topics together from their individual lists (no order, can include their own topics)
  - Separating into 3 groups (groups of 2, 2 and 3 people) by voting, in a way that previous groups mix up
  - Each group makes a list of top 5 topics together from their previous group lists (in order, can include their own topics)
  - The final group listed topics got points based on their position in the lists (1st topic 5 points, 2nd topic 4 points, 3rd topic 3 points, 4th topic 2 points, 5th topic 1 point)
  - The points were summed and hence the final results came out. The 5 topics with the most points became our collective list.
- *ALL* 7 decision making processes that we tried out and that resulted in different lists of 5 topics
  - *democratic* by voting (above mentioned)
  - *practice-based* by choosing what we desire most to try in practice
  - *practice-based* by retrospectively making a list out of the topics we have managed to try in practice
  - *chance* by random selection
  - *authoritarian/power-based* by playing rock-paper-scissors and the winner got to

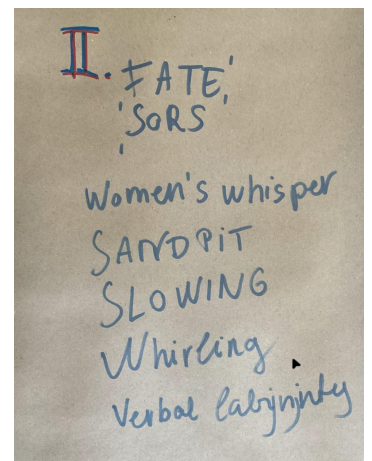
- *relationship-based* by creating a mindmap of all the topics and creating connections between the topics
- *intuitive* by drawing tarot card and interpreting it
- The *FINAL LIST* was generated by voting based decision making between the 7 different decision making processes and their lists: the democratic decision making process won
